2022-2023 SCHOOL PROGRAM OVERVIEW







PROGRAM SUMMARY

In Groundswell's After School Social Justice Art Making program, youth participants explore tenets of social justice and engage in narrative expression across a wide range of arts-based activities. Through a series of weekly workshops, youth develop mixed media skills, learn core principles of design and art-making, understand the ways art and activism generate social change, and build their own body of expressive work.

PROGRAM DETAILS

- Groundswell's Teaching Artist employs youth-centered facilitation practices & anti-oppressive pedagogy
- Groundswell provides all program participants with high-quality art supplies
- Program sessions occur 2x per week for 8 weeks during after school hours, on days determined by School Partner and Groundswell Team
- School Partner appoints an After School Program Liaison to recruit program participants and coordinate onsite program logistics
- School Partner designates a program meeting space that meets all necessary safety and social distancing measures
- Program is open to a group of 10-15 youth participants
- Program concludes with a culminating celebration and showcase of youth work
